| 1 | NO PLASTIC BAGS IN COMPOST CART! Use paper bags or film bags with a certified compostable logo. Contact IWMC for info. |
| 2 | Only clear bags accepted for WASTE material. Please do not use paper bags, or non-transparent or plastic blue bags. |
| 3 | Paper products – Blue Bag #1
Milk cartons, plastic with symbols  -  , & glass – Blue Bag #2 (<i>must be clean & dry</i>)
Metals (<i>more than 50% metal</i>) – Blue Bag #2
Bundle paper bags and corrugated cardboard (<i>including corrugated pizza boxes</i>) and place beside blue bags for collection along with larger, dismantled metal items (<i>within 50 lb & 4 ft</i>). |
| 4 | Maximum weight for carts: 220 lb.
Maximum weight for excess containers & bags: 50 lb. |
| 5 | NO ASHES IN CART! Place ashes in cardboard box beside appropriate cart. |
| 6 | Call IWMC for cart warranty repair. |
| 7 | Item(s) in your cart require special disposal. <i>Examples:</i> electronics, batteries, needles, oil, paint cans, etc. See <i>Sorting Guide for full listing.</i> |

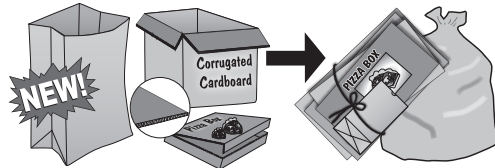

PAPER BAG SORTING CHANGES

Clean and dry paper bags are now recyclable.



PREFERRED METHOD –

bundle paper bags with flattened corrugated cardboard & place beside blue bags for collection.

ALTERNATE METHOD –

if not placing cardboard out for collection, paper bags can go in blue bag #1 with other paper products

NOTE: Paper bags may be used to collect household scraps, however clean & empty bags not used for this purpose do not belong in compost – they are recyclable.
