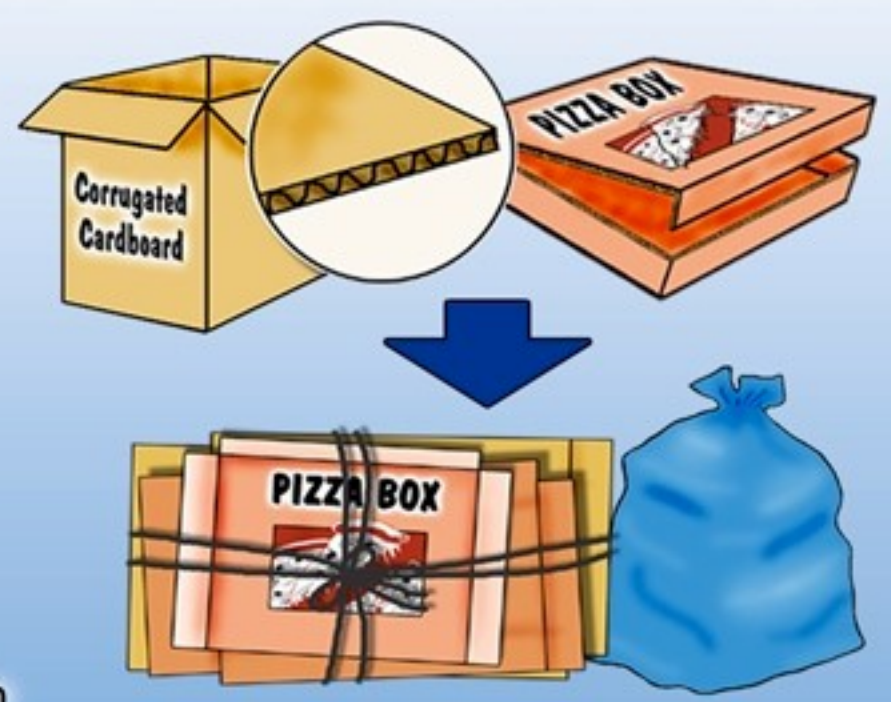

NEW!! **EFFECTIVE MARCH 1st, 2010**
PLACE LARGE METAL ITEMS BESIDE BLUE BAGS

- ✓ bundle multiple items (tent poles, curtain rods, etc.)
- ✗ no heavier than 50 lbs.
- ✗ no longer than 4 feet in any dimension
- ✗ no items containing Freon
