- ✓ boxboard boxes to gather food scraps
- ✓ paper bags
- ✓ compostable film bags
(only ones with either of these logos on them)

IN INDUSTRIAL FACILITIES
Check for the BPI logo on all bags of compostable. Not suitable for backyard composting.

FOR WASTE:

- ✓ Clear, transparent plastic bag
